## CARE PACKAGES FOR JOSH!



Good tidings to our fellow parishioners. We are happy to inform you that our very own member, Josh Barrett, has begun this new school year as a seminarian. St. Luke's has committed funds, to be presented a couple times a year to Josh in support of his holy path. Recently Josh was presented with a check for \$250 to assist with the purchase of required textbooks. This may seem a large sum of money to some, but when you realize textbooks cost \$70, \$100 and in some cases much more, then you can appreciate why we are encouraging the St Luke's family to assist

Josh in any way that they are able. This is all volunteer.

This past spring we announced our desire to periodically send Josh "**CARE PACKAGES.**" Now is the **PERFECT** time to start, so it will coincide with the start of the new life path he is undertaking. So here is what you can do... We are hoping to get a package off to Josh at the End of August/early September. You may recall there is a silver papered box in the parish hall for contributions to the care package.

What does a student need? Well... **snack foods for one...Oreos, Swedish Fish, dark chocolate pretzels, dried fruit, trail mix, cookies, candy, mints, gum, quickie instant dinner foods like Raman noodles, soup in a cup, and macaroni and cheese cups (add water and microwave), fresh home-made brownies and cookies that pack easily and travel well. But there are other types of things as well, flash light and batteries, mini reading light to attach to a book, bar soap, razors, pads of paper, cough drops, tissue packs, Handi-wipes.....** you get the idea. Or, if it is easier for you to contribute some greenbacks to the cause, then you could drop a personal check in the box made out directly to Josh Barrett. We will send monetary gifts along in the card we enclose in the Care Package. Keep in mind that personal notes, cards, and well wishes are appreciated too, so if you have a moment, write Josh some words of encouragement. We will include those also.
